※ The overseas voter registration can be performed by submitting the application to an overseas public office (via visiting, mail, or e-mail)) or via the internet website (<http://ova.nec.go.kr>).

※ Note

1. Because this application is read by a machine, please take caution not to damage it such as folding or tearing the document.
2. Because incorrect information in the application can lead to disadvantages for the applicant (non-registration as overseas voter, inability to receive election information, etc.), please fill in all information legibly and accurately.
3. Those who have falsely registered or those who have not been deemed to have registered on one's own intention cannot participate in voting and can be punished (up to 3 years of imprisonment or up to 5 million KRW in fine) in accordance with Article 247 of the "Public Official Election Act."

※ Tips

1. For the "**Name**" field, you must write the name as shown in the passport (including English).
 - ☞ However, if the name is differently registered on the passport and family relation register (family register), you must write the name on the family relation register (family register).
2. For the "**Overseas Voter Category**" field, the "Canceled Resident Registration Number" must be entered after marking the in the corresponding field for people who had a resident registration number. For people who never had a resident registration number, the "Date of Birth" must be written after marking the in the corresponding field and the must be checked in the corresponding field of "Gender."
3. For the "**Names of Parents**" field, those who never had resident registration number must enter the "Father's Name or Mother's Name" shown in the family relation register (family register) in order for accurate confirmation of citizenship/identification and place of registration (origin of domicile).
4. For the "**Family Relation Registration Information**" field, the "Final Address in Republic of Korea" must be entered after marking the in the corresponding field for people who had a resident registration number (canceled resident registration). For people who never had a resident registration number, the "Place of Registration (Origin of Domicile)" shown in the family relation register (family register) must be written after marking the in the corresponding field.
5. For the "**Phone Number**" and "**Cell Phone Number,**" phone numbers (country code - area code - phone number) such as home/office and cell phone number must be written to enable contact from the residing country.
 - ☞ Because the phone number and cell phone number are used for instructions such as confirmation of overseas voter criteria, voting time/location, and for providing other various election information, you can write down a phone number in Korea that can be contacted if you do not have a foreign number.
6. You must fill in the "E-mail" field because it is used to provide various election-related information/materials such as political party/candidate information prepared/sent by the National Election Commission, notification of voter list registration, guide to appeal application, and voting time/location/requirements
7. For the "**Overseas Address**" field, the location where you can receive mail from the residing country must be accurately written inside the dotted line using the Roman alphabet or uppercase letters (local language can be additionally used).
 - ☞ However, a **public office can be reported as an overseas address to receive mail** for reasons such as work/profession/relocation/unclear address/poor mailing system of the residing country. In this case, after marking the , enter the name of the public office in the "Address" field.
8. For the "**Voting Public Office**" field, write the name of the public office where you will be actually voting during the overseas voting period.
9. For the "**Applicant**" field at the end, you must write your name and sign or seal.
